

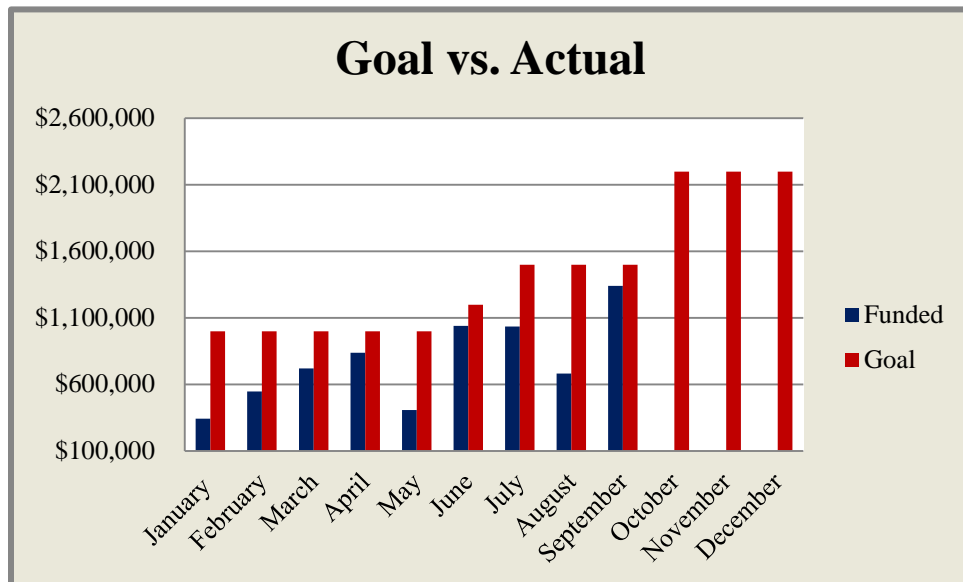
Performance Report September 2017

This report captures NAHAC’s performance through September 2017 for all Nevada Hardest Hit Fund® program dollars distributed and households served. The following metrics provide a snapshot of each program’s activity and are utilized to establish baselines, trends and forecasts.

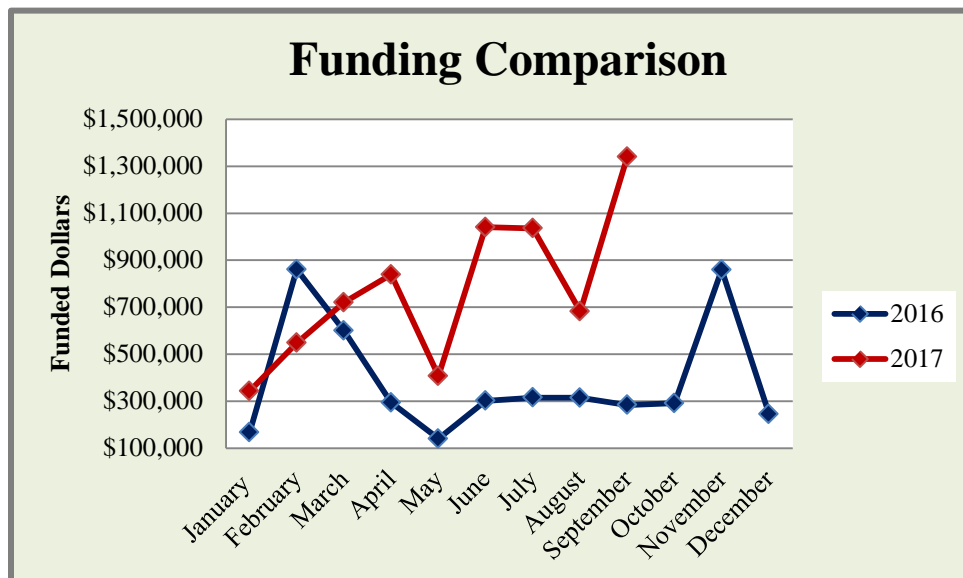
Amounts Funded – Overall:

NAHAC provided assistance to 26 households in September for a total of \$1,340,303.20. The September total was almost double the previous month (\$681,979.96) and 372% higher than the same month in 2016 (\$283,896.68).

The following chart illustrates actual dollars funded compared to funding goals. The overall monthly goal for 2017 for all programs combined was \$1 million for January through May; \$1.2 million for June; \$1.5 million upon deployment of the Nevada Mortgage Assistance System (NMAS), which occurred July 3, 2017; and is set at \$2.2 million for October through December 2017.



The following chart compares combined monthly funding results for all programs for 2016 and 2017.

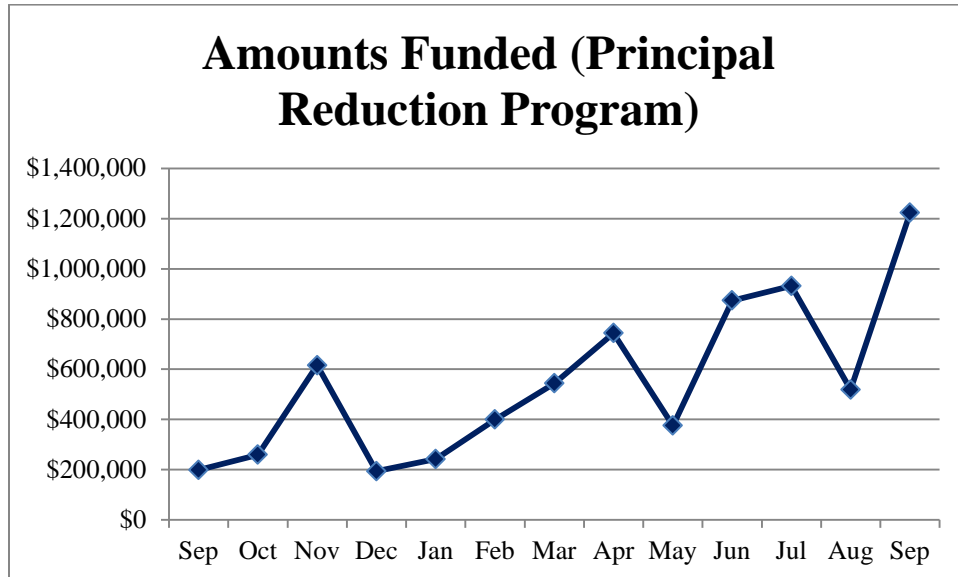

Amounts Funded – By Program:

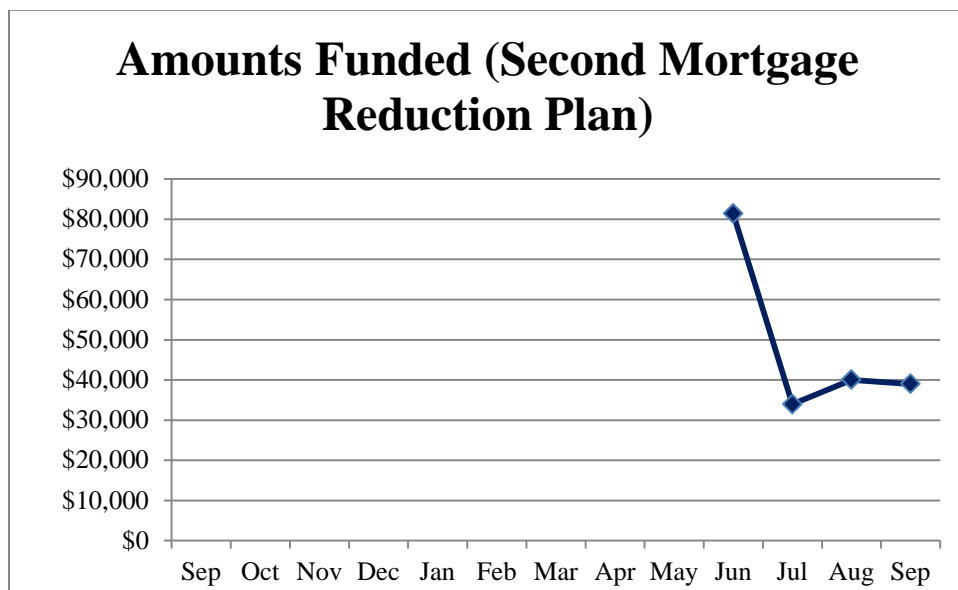
Principal Reduction Program (B-1)

The Principal Reduction Program (B-1) accounted for a majority of the overall total, with 17 files funded for a total of \$1,222,601.44.



Second Mortgage Reduction Plan (B-2)

The Second Mortgage Reduction Program (B-2) had two fundings in September, totaling \$38,982.80.

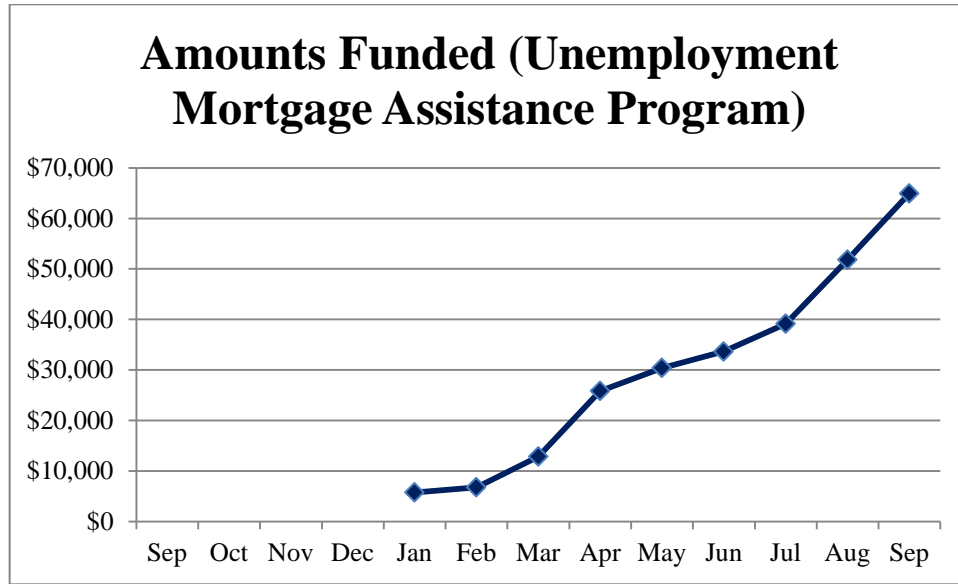

Unemployment Mortgage Assistance Program (B-4U)

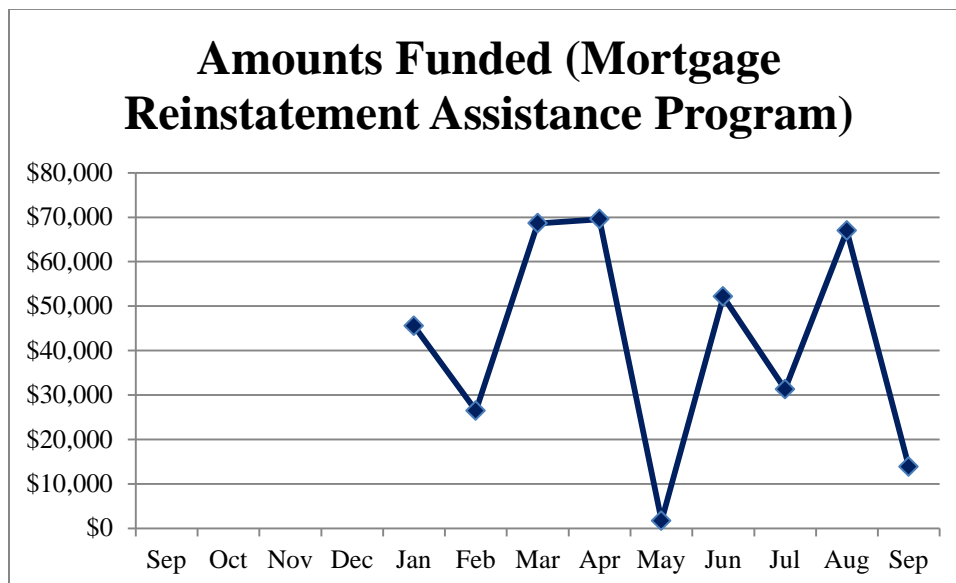
The Unemployment Mortgage Assistance Program (B-4U) had seven files funded for a total of \$10,992.71. Additionally, there were 41 recurring B-4U files funded totaling \$53,973.58 for homeowners who qualified in prior months, and continued to be unemployed and in need of assistance.

Mortgage Reinstatement Assistance Program (B-8)

The Mortgage Reinstatement Assistance Program (B-8) had one funding in September for \$13,823.10.
